During their break, they went through trials and struggles that tested their relationships, including in 2007 when Jeromy was diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis.

Even through the hardships and break from touring, he and Jennifer just couldn't stay away from music. They continued to write music and be involved in leading worship. And after a couple years away from the group, in 2008, the two decided it was time to return to FFH.
